On February 25, the United States Senate failed to advance the Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act. This bill proposed to prohibit the killing of newborn children by ensuring that babies born alive following an abortion would receive the same degree of care to preserve their lives and health as would be given to other children born alive at the same gestational age. It should horrify all of us that our elected officials failed to advance a bill to make clear that killing newborn babies is wrong and should not be tolerated.
