Bishop Peter A. Libasci ordained Rev. David Gagnon and Rev. Joseph Moynahan to the priesthood at St. Joseph Cathedral in Manchester June 5.

“May God bless Father Gagnon and Father Moynahan as they begin their priestly ministry. I ask that you join me in praying for them, and in praying that he continues to bless our diocese with men like them whom he calls to serve his people here in New Hampshire,” the bishop said.

In addition, Bishop Libasci ordained the Rev. Mr. Daniel Mikolajewski, Rev. Mr. Cuong Van Nguyen and Rev. Mr. Roarke (Rory) Traynor to the transitional diaconate May 29. They will serve in diocesan parishes this summer and return to seminary in the fall for their final year of study. ■
