Planned Giving

Planned giving, also referred to as gift planning or legacy giving, is a donor's intention to contribute a planned gift to an organization beyond their lifetime. This is often a continuation of the donations an individual or couple has made while living, but on a larger scale. A planned gift can be made in several forms:

- A cash bequest to a charitable organization in a Will or Trust,
- A gift of stocks or bonds, or
- The designation of a charitable organization as the beneficiary of a life insurance policy, annuity or IRA.

A donor can even specify the purpose of the gift and limit the amount of the gift that the organization may spend annually.
