


My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

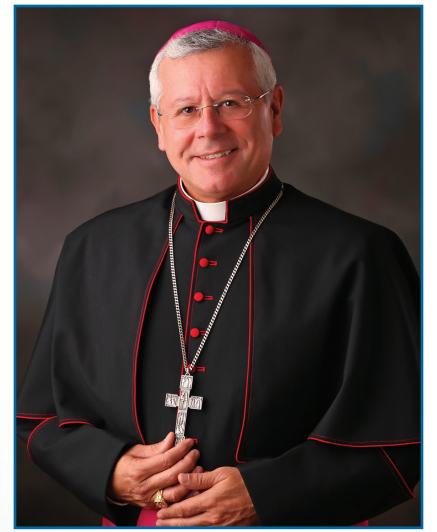
Thank you for sharing your gifts, and may God continue to bless and care for you.

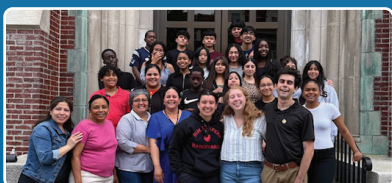

Each parish in our Diocese is given a goal to help achieve the overall Diocesan goal for the NHCA. When parishes reach that goal, 90% of the money raised above it is returned to the parish to be used as needed. As of January 2026, 65 parishes reached their 2025 parish goal! In addition, through the NHCA, parishes that are experiencing financial difficulties can receive aid to support essential needs such as staffing, fuel, or maintenance.

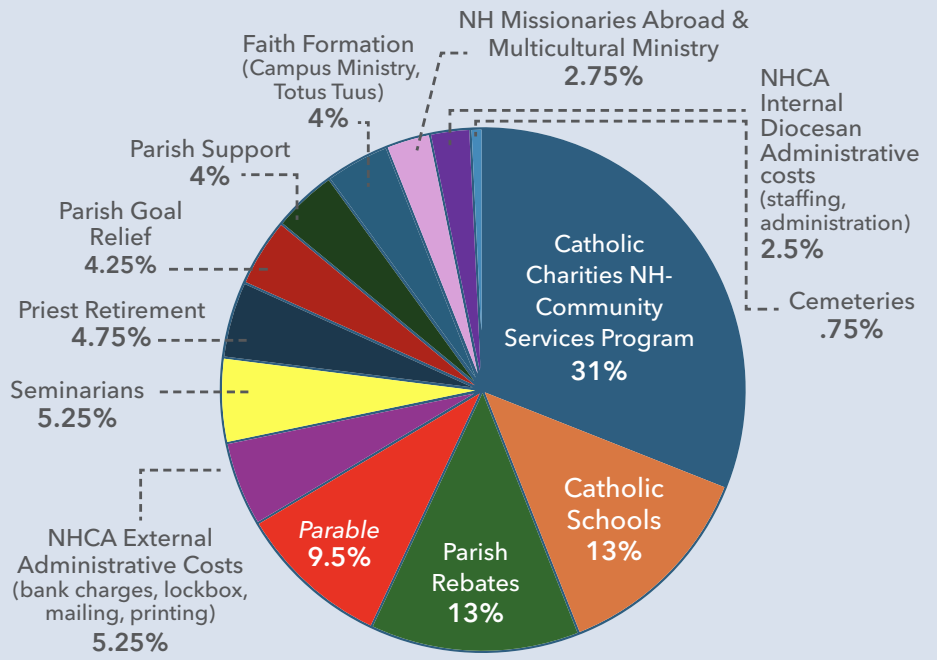

As of 2/2/2026, the New Hampshire Catholic Appeal raised \$4,318,206.79 thanks to your generous support. On 9/30/2025, initial allocations and rebates were issued. Final allocations will be issued based on the estimated budgeted percentages on 3/31/2026 when the 2025 New Hampshire Catholic Appeal ends.
