



# 2026 NATIONAL Eucharistic Pilgrimage

Join us in prayer, holding our nation before the Eucharistic Heart of our Savior, during the 250th Anniversary of the Signing of the Declaration of Independence! The 2026 National Eucharistic Pilgrimage will travel to 18 archdioceses and dioceses on the East Coast of the United States, beginning Memorial Day weekend in St. Augustine, Florida - where the first Mass in the U.S. was celebrated - and concluding in Philadelphia the weekend of July 4. The theme is One Nation Under God with St. Frances Xavier Cabrini, the first American Citizen to be canonized, as the pilgrimage's patroness.

The National Eucharistic Pilgrimage will arrive in the Diocese of Manchester on Saturday, June 20 from the Diocese of Springfield, MA. It will travel through southern New Hampshire for several days, departing for the Diocese of Portland, ME on Tuesday, June 23.
