Local Ordinances on COVID-19

As you may have seen in the news, there has been a growing trend of municipalities adopting ordinances to address COVID-19. So far in New Hampshire, the ordinances appear limited to the wearing of masks. In other states, local ordinances have included specific notice requirements in the event of an outbreak, cleaning and disinfecting requirements after an outbreak, and the requirement to post a mitigation plan. While the Office of Legal Services at the Chancery has been following developments on the federal and state level, it is difficult to follow the developments on these local ordinances.
