Diocese of Manchester Online Training for Parents/Grandparents/Concerned Adults

The Diocese of Manchester is making several training programs available to parents, grandparents, and concerned adults free of charge. Our hope is that these trainings will assist you as in keeping your children safe at home, away from home, and online. The trainings are:

<u>Safe Environment Curriculum- Safe Haven: It's Up to You</u> (consisting of 3 videos. Total watch time is approx. 1 hour)- Learn about the signs potential abusers may display, the grooming process, signs that a child may be abused, and how to report any concerns. This training is <u>required</u> for anyone who plans to work or volunteer in a position involving children.

<u>A Safe Haven Starts at Home</u> (20 mins.)- Learn how to protect and talk with children about internet pornography, cyberbullying, and other online dangers.

<u>Establishing Appropriate Boundaries: The Safe Side of the Line</u> (22 mins.)-Learn about the appropriate boundary expectations we have for adults who work with minors in the Diocese of Manchester.
