Meetings

At least 2 adults must be present at all times

Only meet at Churchsanctioned events



Respect

Speak kindly to minors

Never hit, grab, pinch, etc.

Refer disciplinary issues to supervisor and parent




Communication

Do not text minors

Copy parents on all communications

Only use official accounts



Expressing Affection

High fives, fist bumps, and handshakes are the best ways to greet students



Kissing, tickling, lengthy hugs, and comments about physique are prohibited

Keep Private Matters Private

Don't discuss personal issues with minors, especially sexual info

Refer questions to parents



Convey Catholic Teachings

Remember: You are a representative of the Catholic Church



Do Not:

- Give gifts (except token gifts given to all)
- Take pictures if not your duty
- Meet outside of church
- Provide drugs or alcohol
- Call, text, or private message
- Break rules
- Play favorites
- Overstep your role
