Suggested Responsorial Psalms for School Masses

Compiled by the American Federation Pueri Cantores

INTRODUCTION

In their 2007 pastoral instruction, “*Sing to the Lord, Music in Divine Worship*”, the American bishops put forth the following guidelines on the singing of the Responsorial Psalm:

#155. *The Responsorial Psalm follows the First Reading. Because it is an integral part of the Liturgy of the Word, and is in effect a reading from Scripture, it has great liturgical and pastoral significance. Corresponding to the reading that it follows, the Responsorial Psalm is intended to foster meditation on the Word of God. Its musical setting should aid in this, being careful to not overshadow the other readings.*

#159. *Songs or hymns that do not at least paraphrase a psalm may never be used in place of the Responsorial Psalm.*

#160. *If it is not possible for the Psalm to be sung, the response alone may be sung, while the lector reads the intervening verses of the Psalm “in a manner conducive to meditation on the word of God.”*

The following list of Responsorial Psalms is intended to assist those selecting music for Catholic school Masses and other liturgies. The psalms selected have proven to be successful in school settings; are of high musical quality, memorable, easily taught, and the antiphons will be enthusiastically sung by students of all ages.

Common Psalms: These Common Psalm choices are appropriate for any Mass within a given season, and represent a "basic repertoire" of psalmody which might serve as an introduction to singing in the church year.

Proper Psalms: Fr. Anthony Ruff's "*Responsorial Psalms for Weekday Mass*" (settings for the Advent-Christmas and Lent-Easter seasons) serves as a valuable resource, making it possible for the proper responsorial psalm to be sung at every daily Mass during the seasons of the liturgical year.

The *Pueri Cantores* editorial committee believes that singing the *proper* psalm represents the preferred liturgical goal, and schools that are able are encouraged to explore the rich selection of proper psalms when possible.

HYMNS AND PSALMS FOR THE YEAR OF MERCY

For Use at School Liturgies

Pope Francis has declared a Jubilee Year of Mercy running from December 8, 2015 through November 20, 2016. In a homily given on the announcement of the Year of Mercy, Pope Francis stated the following:

"Here, then, is the reason for the Jubilee: because this is the time for mercy. It is the favorable time to heal wounds, a time not to be weary of meeting all those who are waiting to see and to touch with their hands the signs of the closeness of God, a time to offer everyone, everyone, the way of forgiveness and reconciliation."

The Year of Mercy is a call to the faithful, inviting them to consider ways in which they might better reflect God's compassionate love and forgiveness in their daily lives. As an aid to those in school and parish communities planning liturgies on the theme of mercy, we offer the following selection of hymns.
